Synopsis

Grease is an idyllic portrayal of high school infatuation and 50's cool. Danny and Sandy share a summer romance, thinking it will end with the beginning of school. But Sandy is transferred to Rydell High, where Danny is leader of the leather-jacketed T-Birds. His "too-cool" stature is in jeopardy when he discovers Sandy is a cheerleader, and attempts to avoid showing his real feelings.

Sandy doesn't understand Danny's behaviour to begin with, and is hurt by his hostile manner towards her. Even though she is upset, she still loves him and sings her heart out with *Hopelessly Devoted*.

Danny realizes he loves Sandy more than his "too cool" image. Both Danny and Sandy decide to make the other jealous with Sandy getting help from the Pink Ladies, headed by wise-cracking Rizzo.
